With respect to the actual, ongoing condition of the organization's financial health, the General Manager shall not cause or allow the development of fiscal jeopardy or a material deviation of actual expenditures from Board priorities established in *Ends* policies.

Further, without limiting the scope of the above statement by the following list, the General Manager shall not:

- 1. Indebt the organization in an amount greater than can be repaid by certain, otherwise unencumbered revenue, within 60 days.
- 2. Use any long-term reserves.
- 3. Conduct inter-fund shifting in amounts greater than can be restored to a condition of discrete fund balances by certain, otherwise unencumbered revenues within 30 days.
- 4. Fail to settle payroll and debts in a timely manner.
- 5. Allow the collection of accounts receivable to be undertaken in an untimely manner.
- 6. Allow tax payments or other government ordered payments or filings to be overdue or inaccurately filed.
- 7. Fail to follow accountability requirements of the Saskatchewan Lotteries Trust Fund for Sport, Culture and Recreation, the Non-Profit Corporations Act of Saskatchewan or other relevant legislation.
- 8. Fail to maintain internal controls to ensure the reliability, accuracy and adequacy of financial recording.

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
