Please note: *The Culture Days Hub Sponsorship application officially opens in March 2026 (upon approval of funds for the 2026 program). The official Culture Days Hub Sponsorship application that appears on the Online Grant Platform may involve additional steps, requirements, and criteria beyond what is outlined in this form.*
