Eligible Applicants are:

- Registered Non-Profit organizations in Saskatchewan with priority to Métis-led organizations.
 Organizations that are not Métis-led may still apply, but they should emphasis and provide evidence of relationship and partnership with Métis peoples for a project. All non-profit organizations must:
 - have a primarily cultural mandate in Arts, Heritage, Multiculturalism or Cultural Industries as defined by <u>SaskCulture's Cultural Policy</u>, or otherwise demonstrate significant engagement in cultural activity;
 - be in existence as a registered non-profit for at least one full fiscal year. If your organization has been incorporated for less than a year, please contact the SaskCulture consultant to discuss options.
 - be in good standing with Information Services Corporation (ISC) and have no outstanding grant follow-ups due to SaskCulture; and
 - provide a copy of the organization's signed annual financial statement that was most recently submitted to the Information Services Corporation (ISC) to show evidence of good standing as a non-profit organization in Saskatchewan.
 - Note: Organizations receiving Annual Global Funding are not eligible to apply.

OR be a:

- Municipality. The applicant must:
 - o be in good standing with the Saskatchewan Lotteries Community Grant Program; and
 - o have no outstanding grant follow-ups due to SaskCulture.

Ineligible Applicants:

• If your organization does not meet the eligibility requirements contact the SaskCulture Outreach Consultant to discuss what alternate project funds might be available to you. Unincorporated community groups may consider forming a partnership with an eligible organization to meet the eligibility requirements for this grant program.
