



## **Creative Kids Northern Cultural Fund**

### **Applicant Eligibility**

**Eligible Organizations** - To be considered for funding, applicants must meet the following eligibility:

- Be a registered non-profit organization in Saskatchewan, which includes Métis Locals/Regions. The applicant must:
  - be in existence as a registered non-profit for at least one full fiscal year; and
  - plan to operate the proposed project within the Northern Sport, Culture and Recreation District; and
  - have a primarily cultural mandate in Arts, Heritage, Multiculturalism or Cultural Industries as defined by SaskCulture's Cultural Policy, or otherwise demonstrate significant engagement in cultural activity; and
  - have no outstanding grant follow-ups due to SaskCulture.

**OR**

- Be a First Nation or Municipality. The applicant must:
  - be in good standing with the Saskatchewan Lotteries Community Grant Program; and
  - be located within the Northern Sport, Culture and Recreation District; and
  - have no outstanding grant follow-ups due to SaskCulture.

**OR**

- Be a School. The applicant must:
  - be located within the Northern Sport, Culture and Recreation District; and
  - have no outstanding grant follow-ups due to SaskCulture; and
  - the proposed programming must take place outside of regular school curriculum hours.

*Preference will be given to programs that are facilitated by youth (under 30) for children and youth (between 4 and 19).  
Community partnerships are encouraged.*

**Projects that are submitted that do not meet the eligibility requirements will not be reviewed. Please consult with the Northern Sport, Culture and Recreation District for options.**
